DISABILITY PARKING PLACARD FOR DISABLED RHODE ISLAND VETERANS

You must be 100% service-connected disabled to receive a placard.

Disabled Veterans should provide a copy of Veterans Administration War Related Disabled Declaration Letter.

You must be a Rhode Island resident.

Additional documentation may be required.
